

**WR BAND BOOSTERS  
MEETING MINUTES  
13 NOVEMBER 2007**

Jim Tingerthal, President, opened the meeting. It was noted that there were no minutes taken for the October booster meeting, as the secretary left town without designating an alternate.

Trieste Stringer, VP of Operations, says she is already looking at ideas for next year.

Kitty Hampel, Uniform Mom, mentioned that some students will need to order concert attire and stated the price is the same as last year. Our treasurer suggested adding \$1.50 to each order to cover the delivery charges.

Sylvia Enix, Treasurer, reported that \$182,002.07 in revenue has been received for the period ending 31 Oct 07; and \$132,968.09 expended. There is a \$56,639.11 checking account balance and \$18,705.56 money market account balance. Sylvia mentioned that it will be vital for the band to have the fair share program implemented next year. It was suggested that this program be explained at the middle school level to avoid scaring parents away.

Jim T. thanked everyone for their volunteer hours during the HoG and remarked that the day was wildly successful. Also noted, we are still in need of a truck driver for next year.

Percussion rehearsals are on-going in preparation for the Christmas concert.

Todd Howell, Band Director, reported as follows:

- Our next booster meeting will be held 4 Dec 07.
- The Christmas Concert will be on 11 Dec 07, at 7 p.m., in the Civic Center.
- The band had a fantastic competition season. The kids did a great job during a rebuilding year, as the band consisted of 42% freshman students.
- Band composite pictures will be taken before the Christmas break.
- WRHS is hosting the honor band tryouts on 8 Dec 07.
- We had a tremendous HoG this year. The weather was gorgeous. We received some very interesting and very high-praise comments from our visitors. Kudos to the website. It really helped us out this year.
